		Seating functions: seat belts, chest strap, rotating/locking positions, seat height adjustments, leg strap, foot plate, arm rests		
		Demonstration of hand operating controls: Forward, Reverse, Turning/ steering; general & on green surface, Seat switch, speed adjustment, including acceleration, slowing down and coming to a complete stop		
		ON/OFF switch: Key must be in OFF position during all transfers, seat rotations, actuations up-down and golf swings.		
		Golf bag positioning, securing. (Positioning seat so not to interfere with swing follow thru.)		
		Explanation of where to drive, park and position the single rider golf car during play, as follows: #1) Adhere to golf course rules and restrictions at time of use. Be aware of all uneven terrains such as driving on/off cart paths, tee/greenside slopes, irrigation heads, etc. #2) Always drive straight up/down steep slopes. Park and position golf car on level terrain to avoid loosing balance and/or golf car rollovers. #3) Steer golf car to navigate the widest turn possible on all green surfaces and tee stations when approaching and leaving. Paramobile 3-wheeled cars should use EXTREME CAUTION to not turn while on greens – this WILL cause turf damage! Single-rider cars may be allowed in sand bunkers only when a safe entrance and exit location is determined and considering weight/density of sand. If unsafe to drive into the bunker, play the ball as local rules apply or Free Drop no closer to the hole. PLAY FAST, PLAY OFTEN AND HAVE FUN!!
